



Armstrong Atlantic State University Navigate Armstrong Orientation Leader Application

Orientation Leader applicants need to meet the following requirements:

- Each candidate must be a full-time degree-seeking undergraduate student and have completed 9 credit hours at AASU by January of the year you are applying to be a Navigate Armstrong Orientation Leader.
- Each candidate must have at least a 2.1 overall grade point average at the time of application and this average must be maintained throughout tenure.
- No student may hold the position while on academic or disciplinary probation as defined by the Student Code of Conduct or Academic Honor Code.

Basic Obligations:

All selected Navigate Armstrong Orientation Leaders must participate in formal training sessions and attend all orientation programs. Also, commitment to program is for 1 year. Program Dates are as follows:

Orientation Leaders must remain in good academic and judicial standing with the University during their tenure in the position, not violate the Student Code of Conduct, and conduct themselves in an appropriate manner as is reflected by the Student Conduct Code both in person and electronically via the Internet (myspace.com, Facebook, etc).

Selection Process:

- Applications available online and in the Office of Students Activities and Student Affairs starting **April 3, 2007**.
- All application materials due **NO LATER** than **Wednesday, April 18, 2007, at 5pm** in the Office of Students Activities or Office Student Affairs located on the 2nd floor, Memorial College Center
- Individual Interviews (by invitation) will take place the week of **April 23-27, 2007**
- Following the completion of Individual Interviews, selections will be made and candidates will be notified.
