

**Office of Disability Services / Plant Operations Campus Physical Improvements
2007-2008 School Year**

Assessment: Disability Services staff used verbal feedback from two students with mobility impairments about areas that were difficult to negotiate on campus and worked closely with Plant Operations to review campus accessibility against federal accessibility standards.

Requested Changes: Both students with mobility impairments requested additional automatic door openers. With construction of the new entrance ways on campus, the location and accessibility of the bus stop also became an issue.

Learning Outcome: Students with mobility impairments were able to voice their needs in an effective manner to implement change on campus.

Changes made due to response: With input from the Office of Disability Services, Plant Operations arranged for the following campus physical improvements on campus during the 2007-2008 school year:

Wheelchair ramps and automatic door openers were installed at the front entrances of Solms, Hawes, Gamble and Victor Halls. Side entrances were already accessible, but this gives these buildings two accessible entryways.

Automatic door opener was installed at MCC Dining Room.

Automatic door openers were installed for both buildings in Science Center complex.

Automatic door opener was replaced for Ashmore Hall.

Sidewalk and curb cuts and accessible shelter were installed for new bus stop on Abercorn St. in front of Burnett Hall.

Renovation of Ashmore Auditorium was completed to include multiple wheelchair accessible seating and ramp to stage area.

Additional curb cuts were installed on main roads of campus.
