Frequently Asked Questions...

What is the Major Field Test (MFT)?

Major Fields Tests are objective tests designed to assess the mastery of concepts, principles and knowledge expected of students at the conclusion of a major in specific subject areas. In addition to factual knowledge, the tests evaluate students' ability to analyze and solve problems, understand relationships and interpret material. They contain questions that call for information as well as questions that require interpretation of graphs, diagrams and charts based on material related to the field. Seven academic departments at AASU require one of the Major Field Tests for an exit exam. The tests are offered every semester by the Office of Testing Services. Graduating seniors must comply with departmental procedures regarding major field exams.

What if I cannot attend my scheduled test session?

If you are absent or expect to be absent, please call the Student Affairs Office (912) 344-2582 at least 5 business days prior to your scheduled test to reschedule for a different date. Request received after the registration deadline will not be honored.

May I take the test before my final term of enrollment?

You must have the test information and request form with the test date for which you register in order to pay for your test. This form is issued by the Assistant Registrar upon his receipt of a Graduation Application. You may ask the Assistant Registrar, located in Victor Hall, to approve an early test date and provide the request form.

Test Takers with Disabilities

How do I pay for the exam?

Cash or Check in Person:

Take the Registration Form and fee to the Bursars Office in Burnett Hall, Monday-Friday, 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Make checks payable to AASU

Visa/Mastercard in Person:

Take Registration Form, Credit Card and Identification to the Bursars Office in Burnett Hall, Monday-Friday, 8:30a.m-4:30 p.m.

Late Registration: Students who fail to meet the listed registration deadlines or miss the test date will be assessed a **\$10 late fee** for processing purposes.
