The SAT On-Campus is an entry level college test used solely for students seeking admission into Armstrong Atlantic State University.

Registering for the SAT

Cash, Check in Person: Take the Registration Form and fee to the Bursars Office in Burnett Hall, Monday-Friday, 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Make checks payable to AASU

Visa/Mastercard in Person: Take Registration Form, Credit Card and Identification to the Bursars Office in Burnett Hall, Monday-Friday, 8:30a.m-4:30 p.m.

On the day of the Exam

Report to Solms Hall, Room 108, no later than the time listed with your test date below. See the campus map on the reverse side for building #12. Late arrivals may be denied admission. Bring a government-issued ID or student ID with a recent photo and signature, several No. 2 pencils and a calculator, if you want to use one on the mathematics sections of the test. Test sessions last approximately four (4) hours. **Note: You may retake the SAT On-Campus only once.** Applicants who are Non-Traditional or Non-Degree seeking students are not required to take the SAT On-Campus.

Score reporting

Your scores will be mailed to you and reported only to the Armstrong Atlantic State University Admissions Office. Scores earned on the SAT-On Campus cannot be used to fulfill the reading comprehension requirement of the Regents' Test.

Absence from the test

If you cannot attend the test for which you registered, you may send a written request for a refund of \$10 and a Self-addressed, stamped envelope to: Testing Services, Armstrong Atlantic State University, MCC Rm 211, 11935 Abercorn St., Savannah, GA 31419-1997. Your request must be postmarked no later than ten (10) days following the test date.

Scheduling a new test date

If you cannot attend the test for which you are registered and want to take the SAT On-Campus on another date, submit a request for a refund as stated above, fill out a new registration form, and pay the full test fee.

Don't forget that registration for the SAT On-Campus closes three weeks prior to the test date.

There is no walk-in registration for this test.

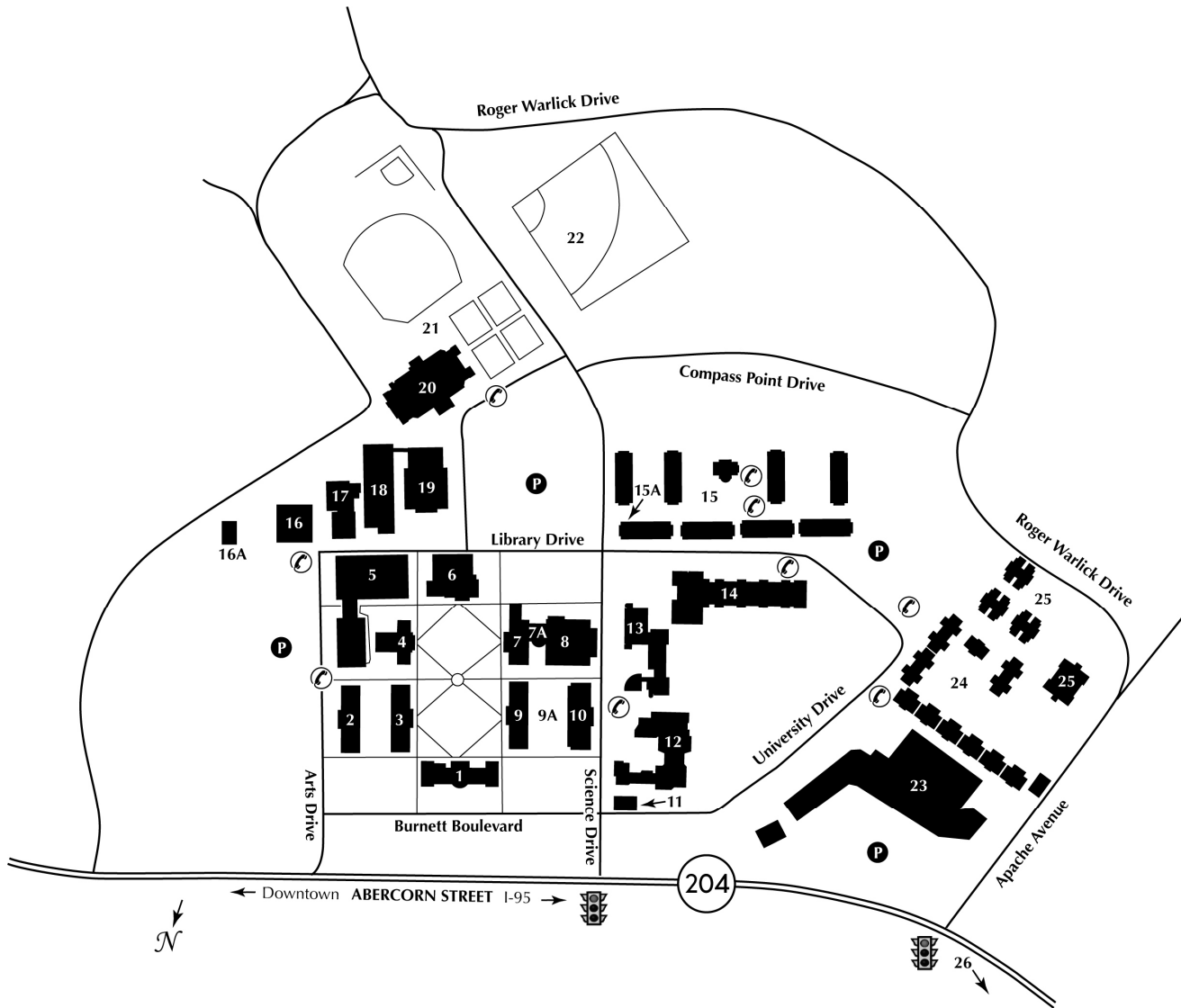
