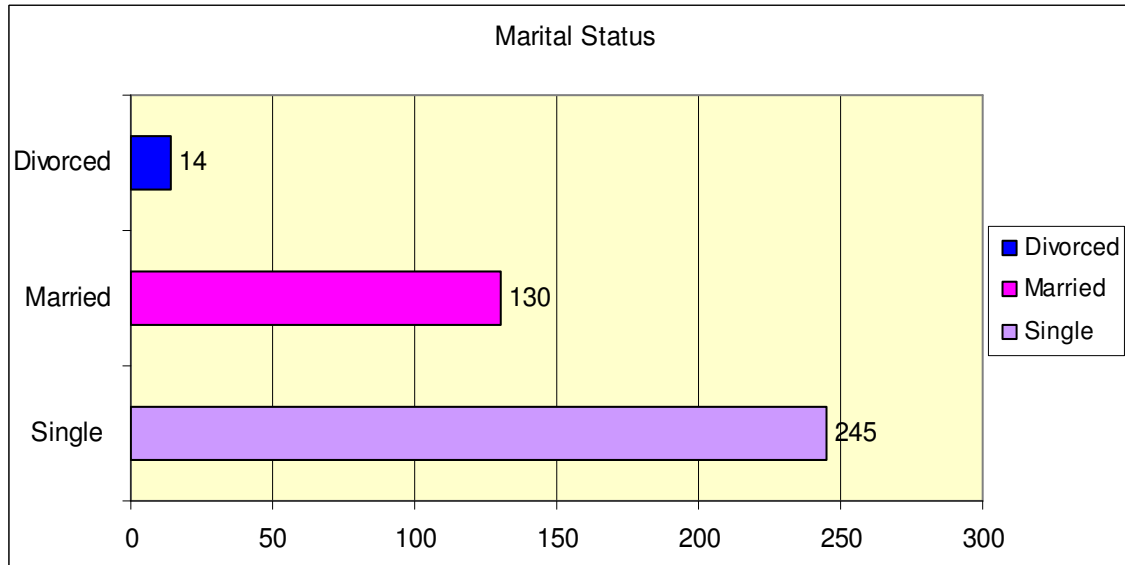


May 2009 Graduates Survey Results

This report summarizes the data gathered from the May 2009 Graduates Survey administered on May 8, 2009. A total of 405 students took part in submitting this voluntary information.

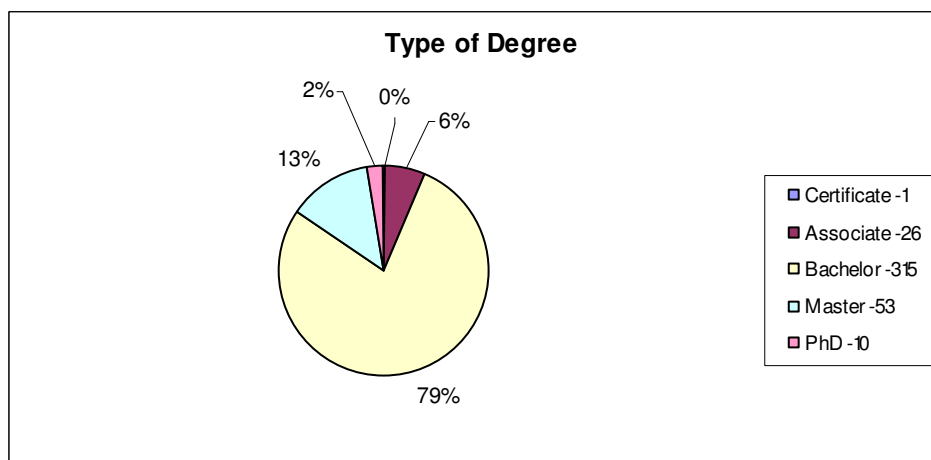
Marital Status

Of the 389 respondents to this question, 245 or 63% were single and 130 or 33% reported that they were married.



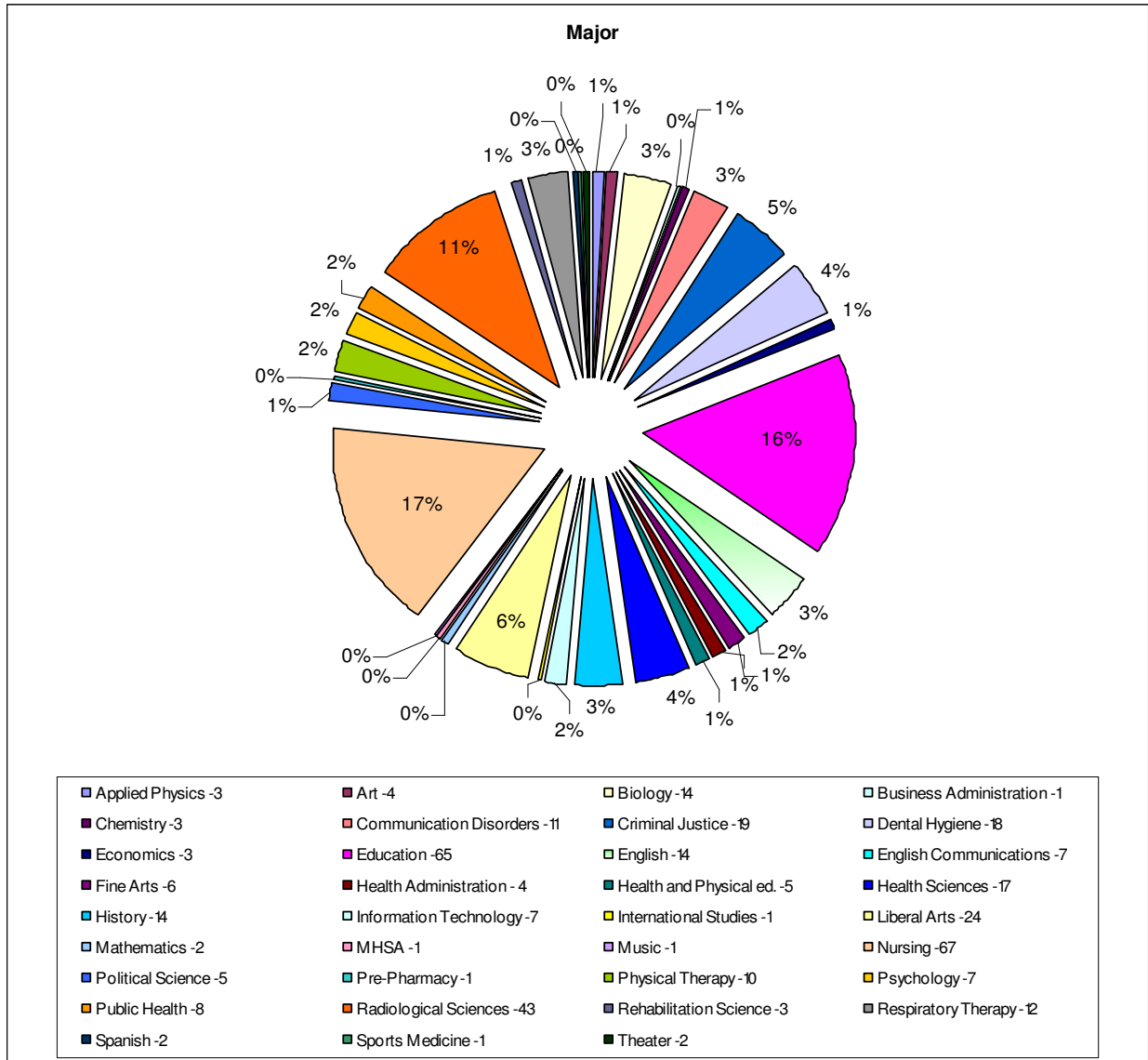
Degree

Overall 315 or 79% of the graduating class completed a Bachelor's degree, 53 or 13% completed a Master's degree, and 26 or 6% completed an Associate degree. For the first time ever, 10 students noted Doctorate degrees in Physical Therapy (DPT).



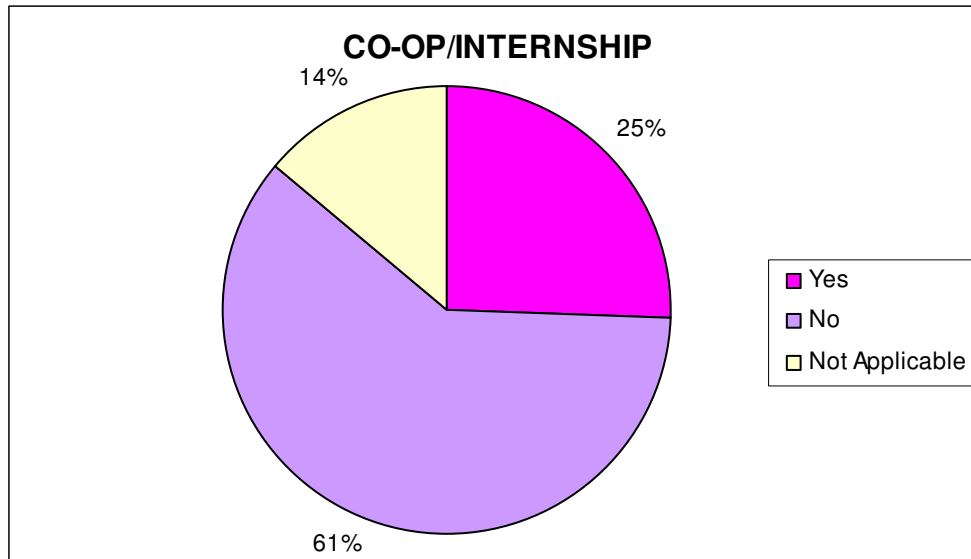
Major

The majority of students completed degrees in Health Professions totaling 195 or 48% followed by 103 or 25% in Liberal Studies and 70 or 17% in Education.



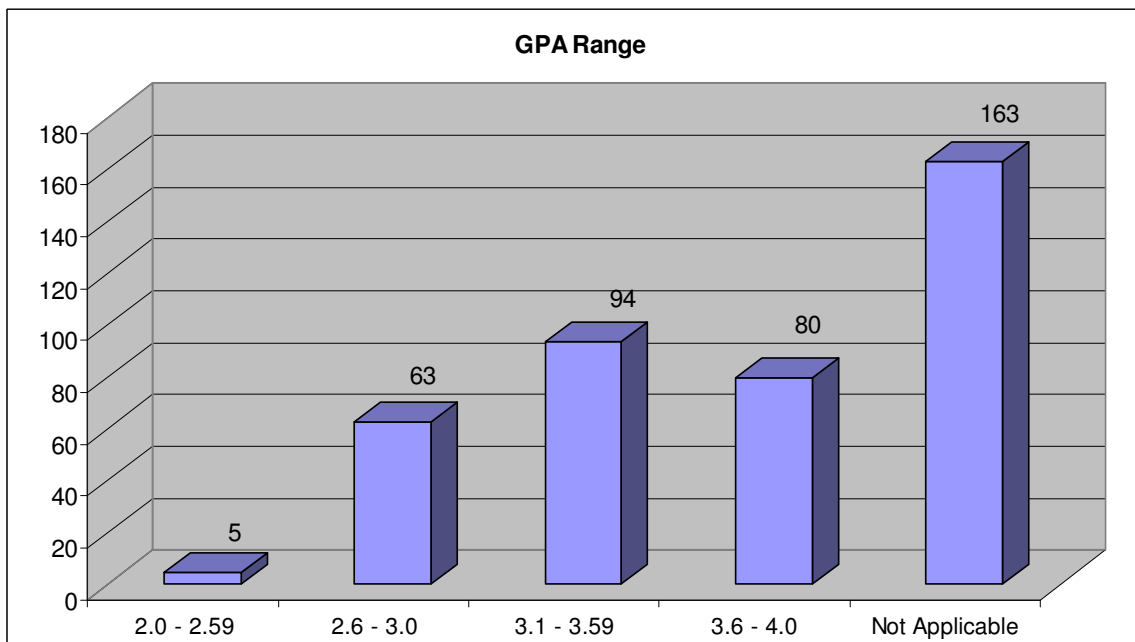
CO-OP/Internship

103 or 25% noted that they participated in a coop/internship while enrolled. 246 or 61% stated that they did not complete a coop/internship and 56 or 14% did not answer.



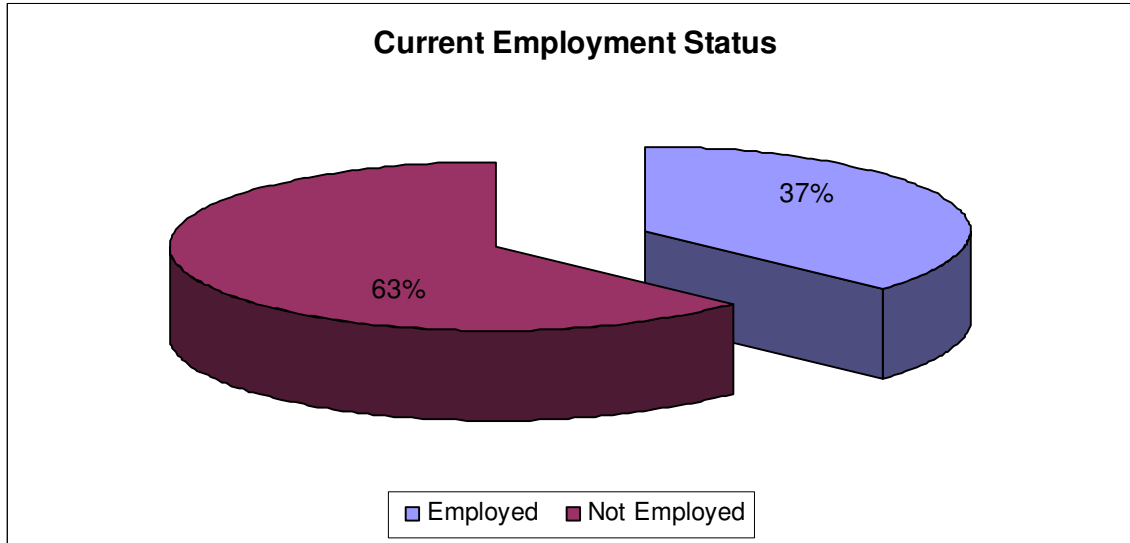
GPA Range

Of the 242 students who responded to this question, 94 or 39% reported a GPA of 3.1-3.59 followed by 80 with GPA's above a 3.6.



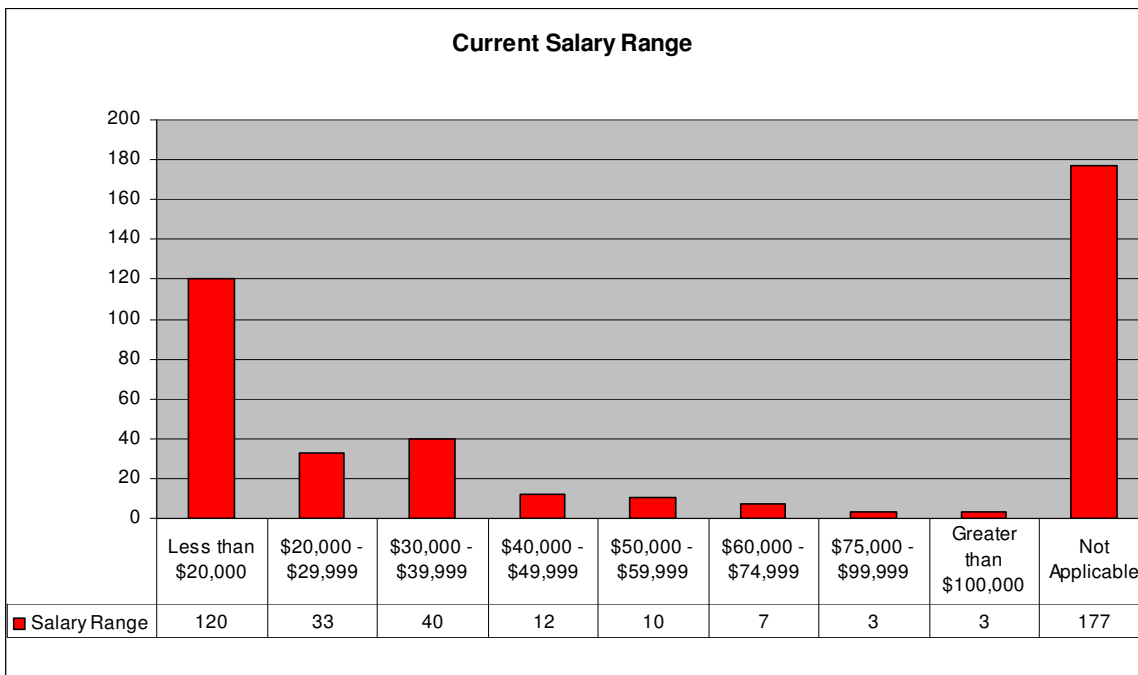
Employment Status

151 or 37% of graduates reported that they were working while 255 or 63% did not list employment.



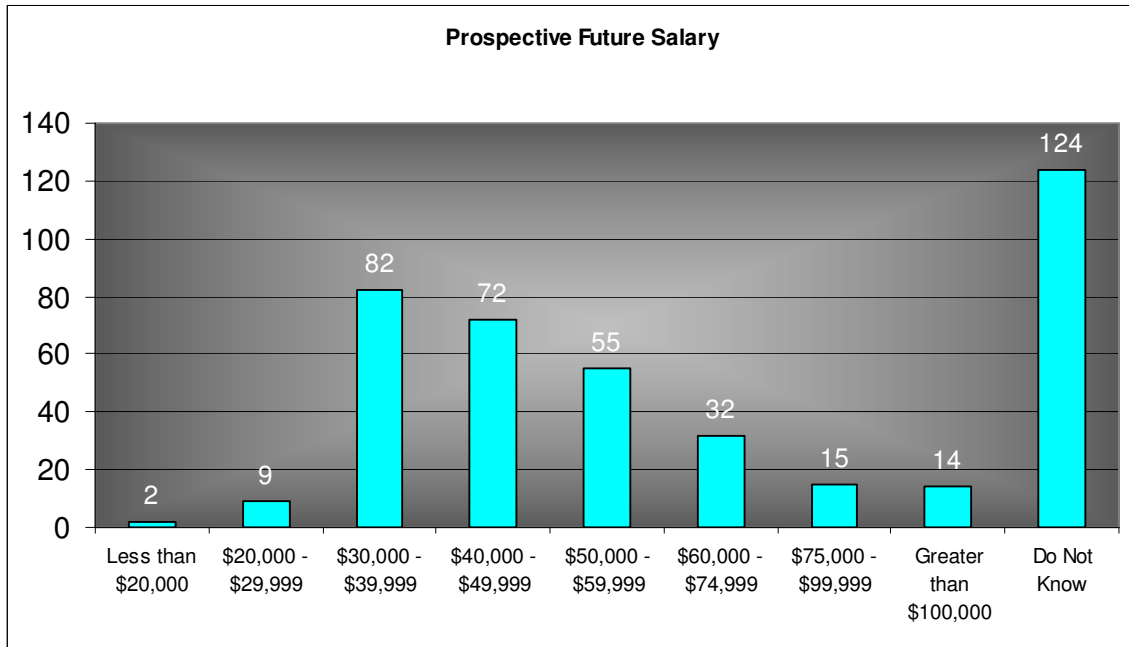
Current Salary Range

While 151 students stated that they were employed 228 reported current salary ranges. Of those reporting current salary ranges a large number 120 or 53% reported making less than \$20,000/year. Forty students reported making between \$30,000 - \$39,999 while 23 or 10% reported making salaries above \$50,000/year.



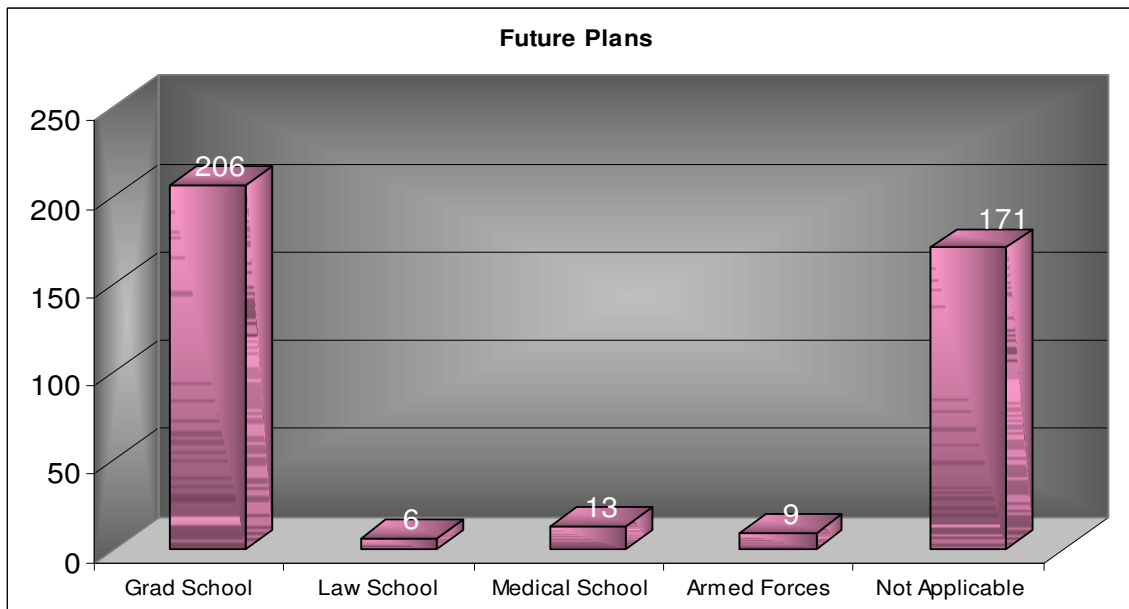
Prospective Future Salary

Of the 405 students who took the survey 281 responded to this question. The highest number of respondents (82) stated their potential salary range was \$30,000-\$39,999 followed by 72 between \$40,000-\$49,999. 116 reported potential earnings above \$50,000.



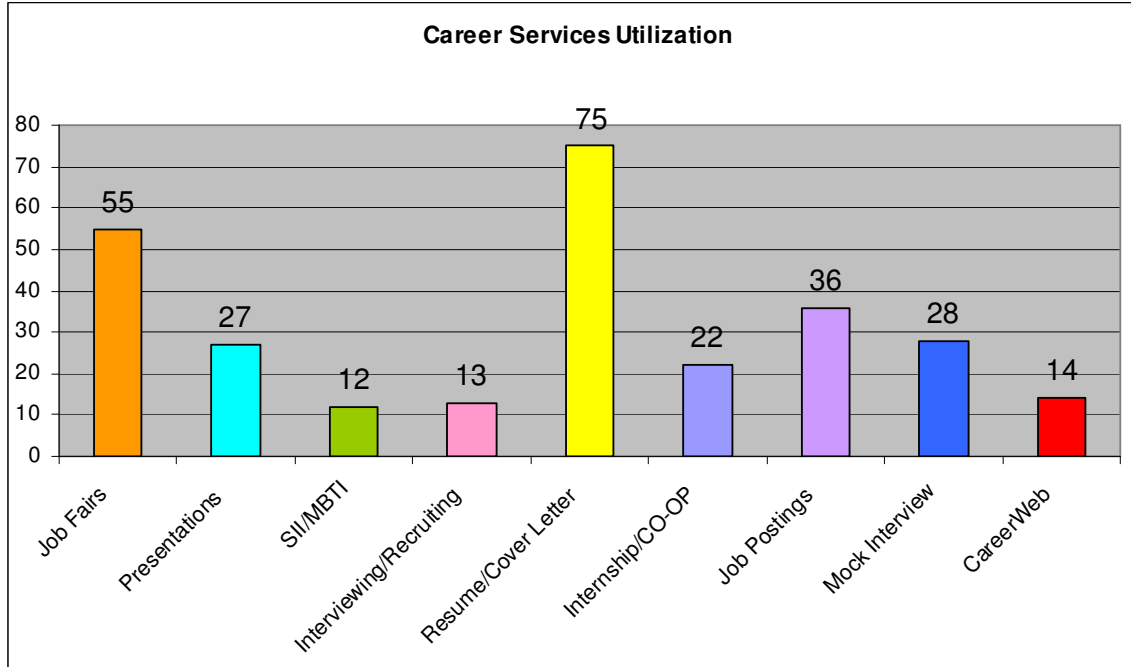
Future Plans

A large number of graduates have plans to pursue Graduate School after graduation at the rate of 206 or 51%. This number coupled with the number of those who will pursue law school (6), medical school (13) and armed forces (9) account for an overall success rate of 58% or 234. 171 or 42% were uncertain.



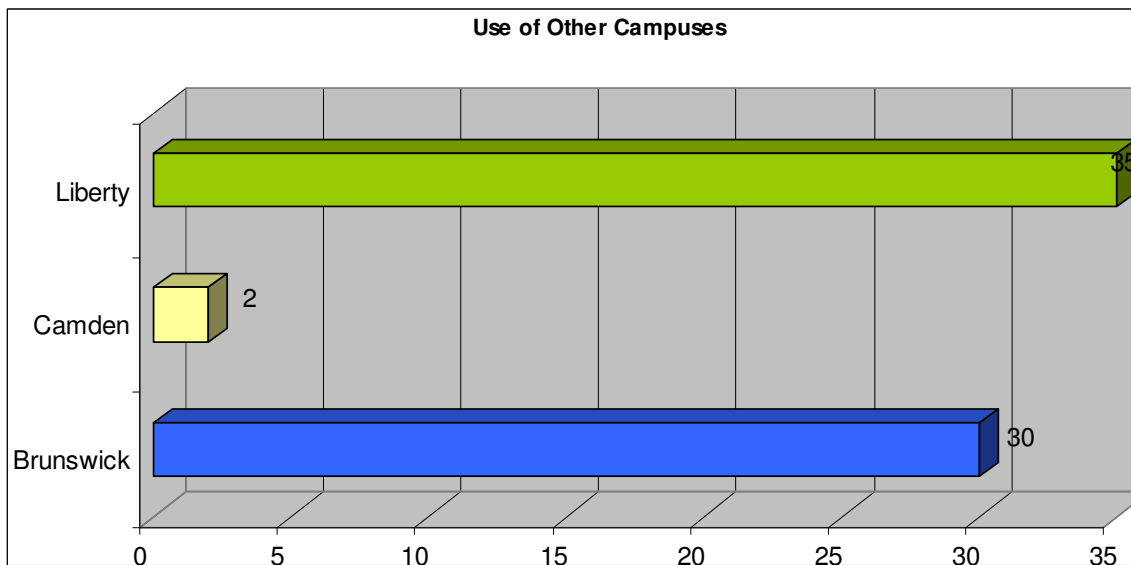
Career Services

There were a total of 282 responses to services utilized by Career Services. The highest response was reflected in those receiving assistance with their resume/cover letter followed by 55 having attended a career fair.



Other Campuses

67 students reported using other campuses; 35 attended the Liberty Center and 30 attended the Brunswick Center. There were only 2 to report usage of the Camden campus.

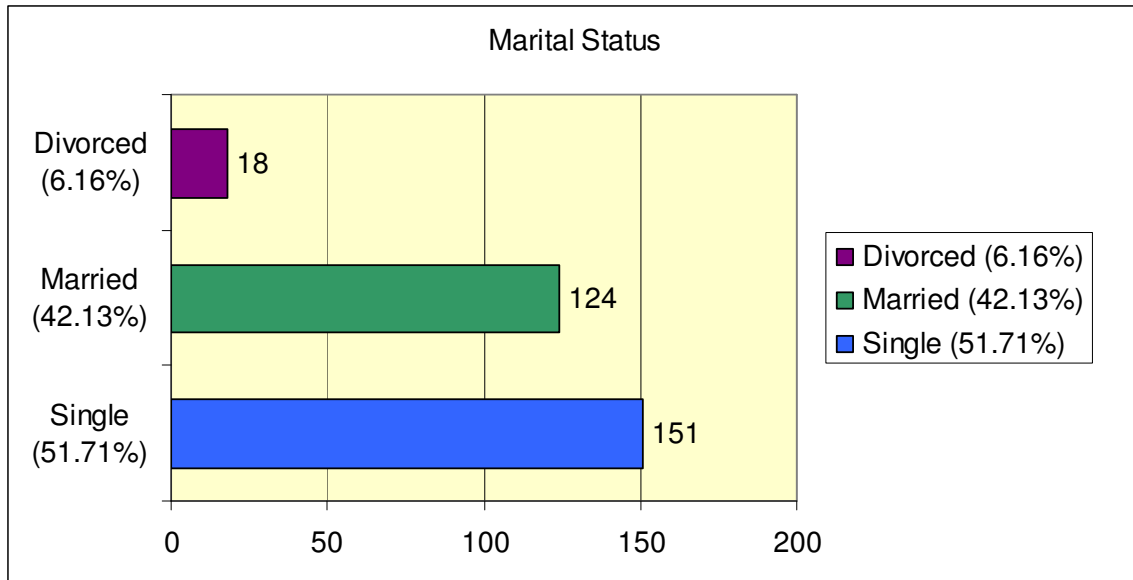

This report summarizes the data gathered from the December 2008 Graduates Survey administered on December 12, 2008. A total of 292 students took part in submitting this voluntary information.

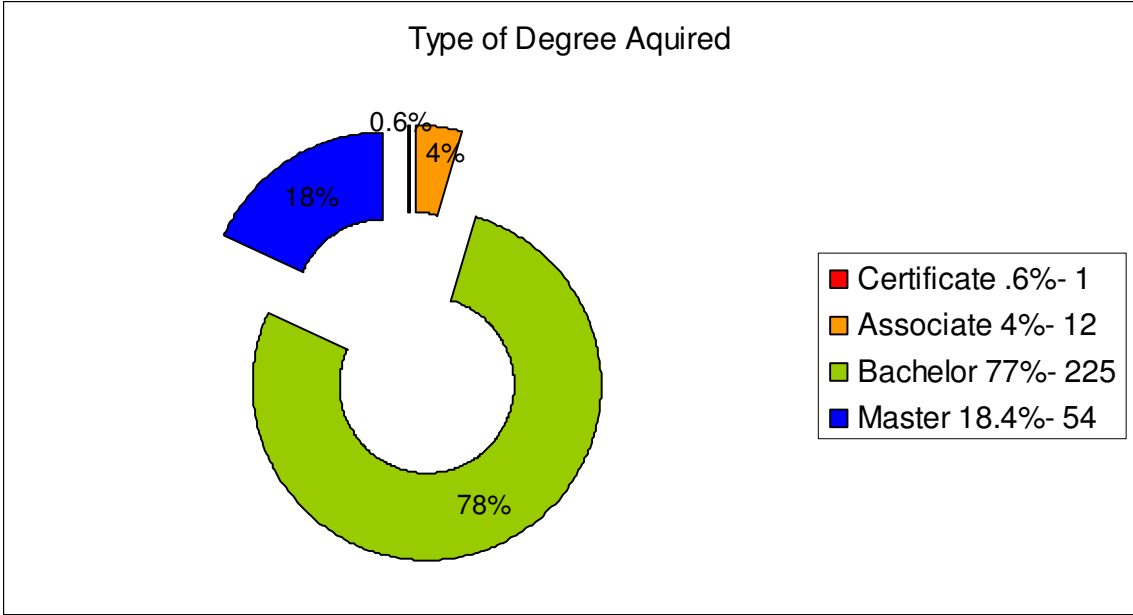
Marital Status

151 or 52% of the graduating class was single, while 124 or 42% were married.



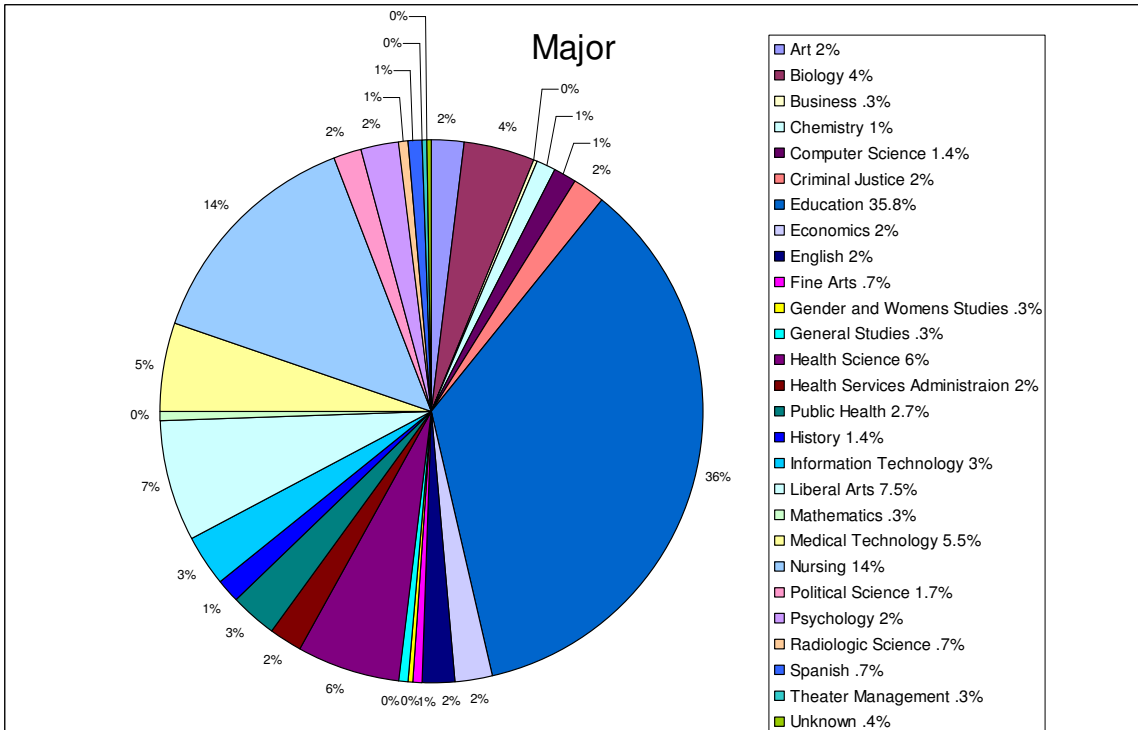
Degree

Overall 77% of the graduating class completed a Bachelor's degree, 18.4% completed a Master's degree, and 4% an Associate's degree.



Major

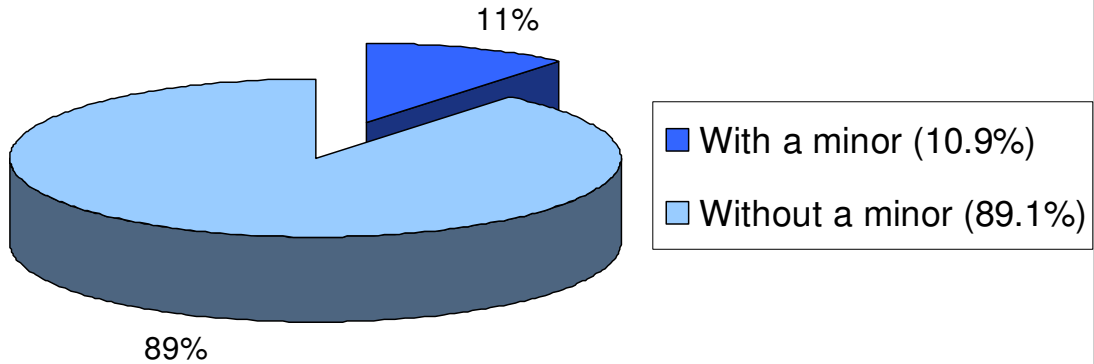

Minor

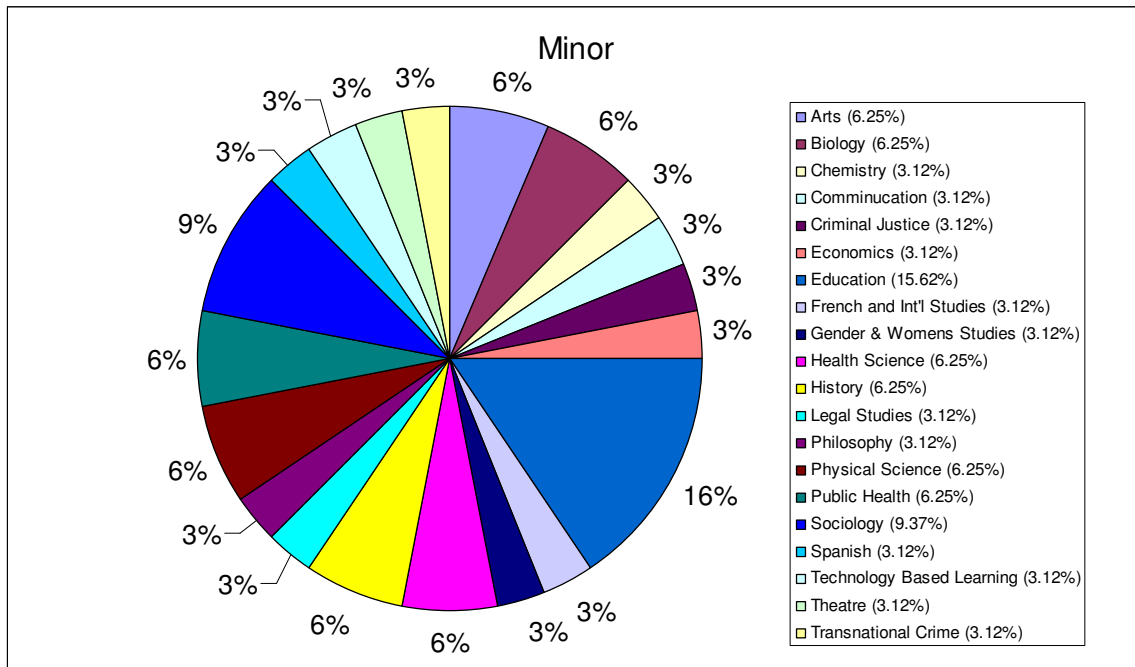
Thirty-two or 10.9% of graduates reported that they completed a minor while 260 or 89% did not.

Those Students Graduating With/Without a Minor



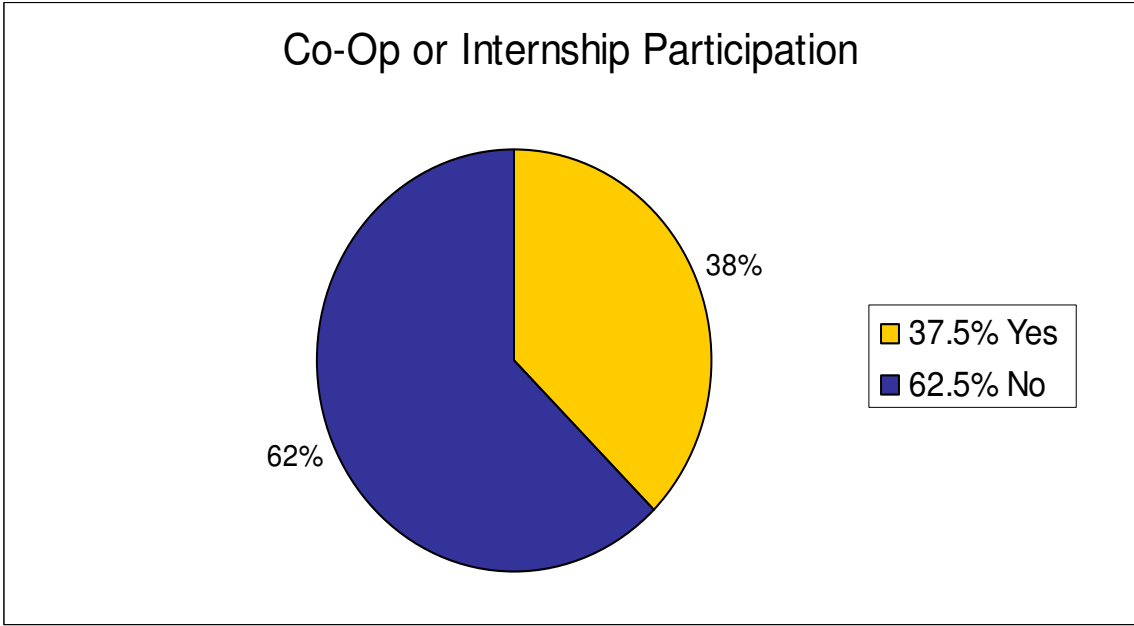

72% or 23 completed a minor in Arts & Sciences, 4 or 12.5% in Health Professions, and 5 or 15.6% in Education.



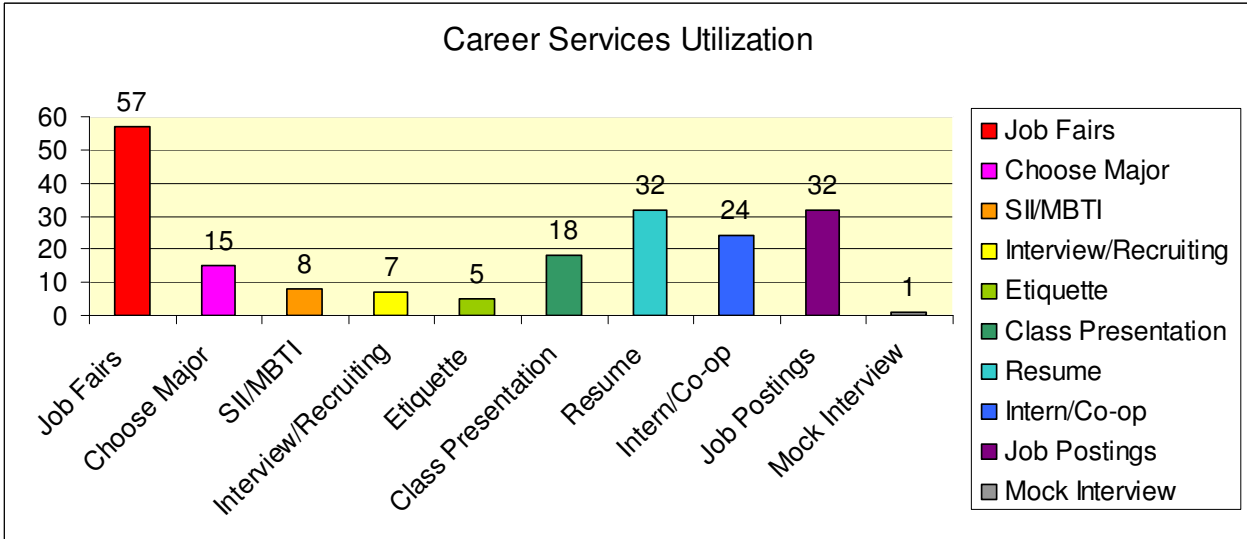
Co-Op/Internship

Over 37% stated that they completed a co-op and/or internship while enrolled at AASU.



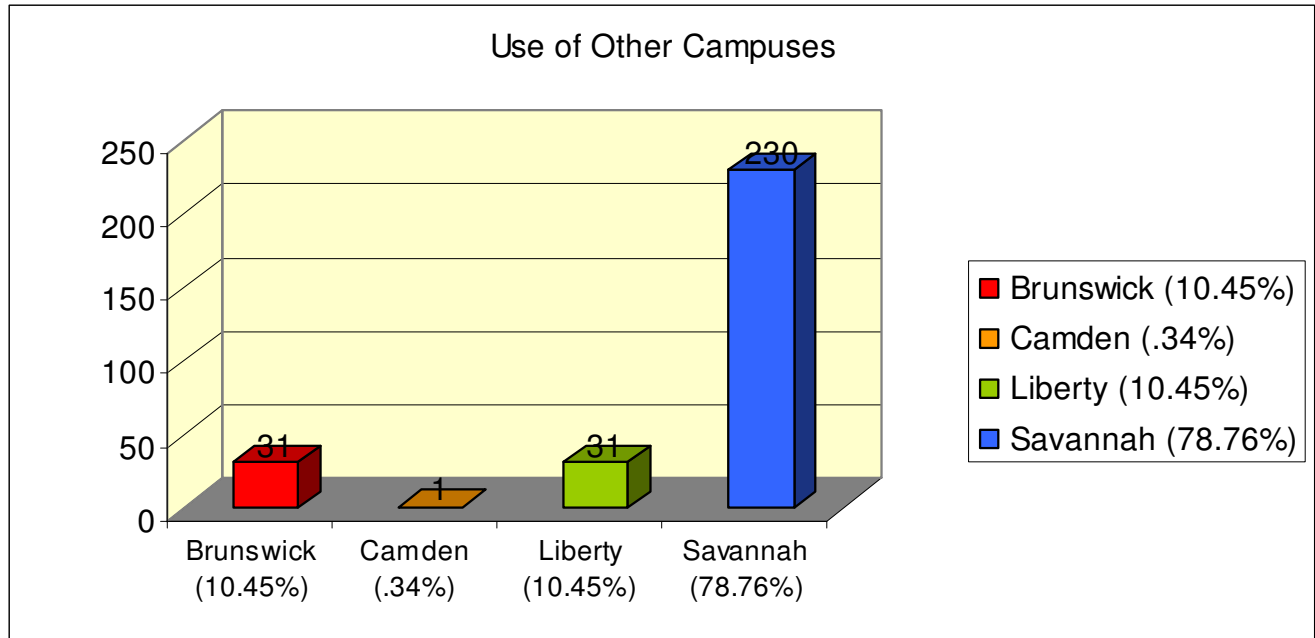
Career Services

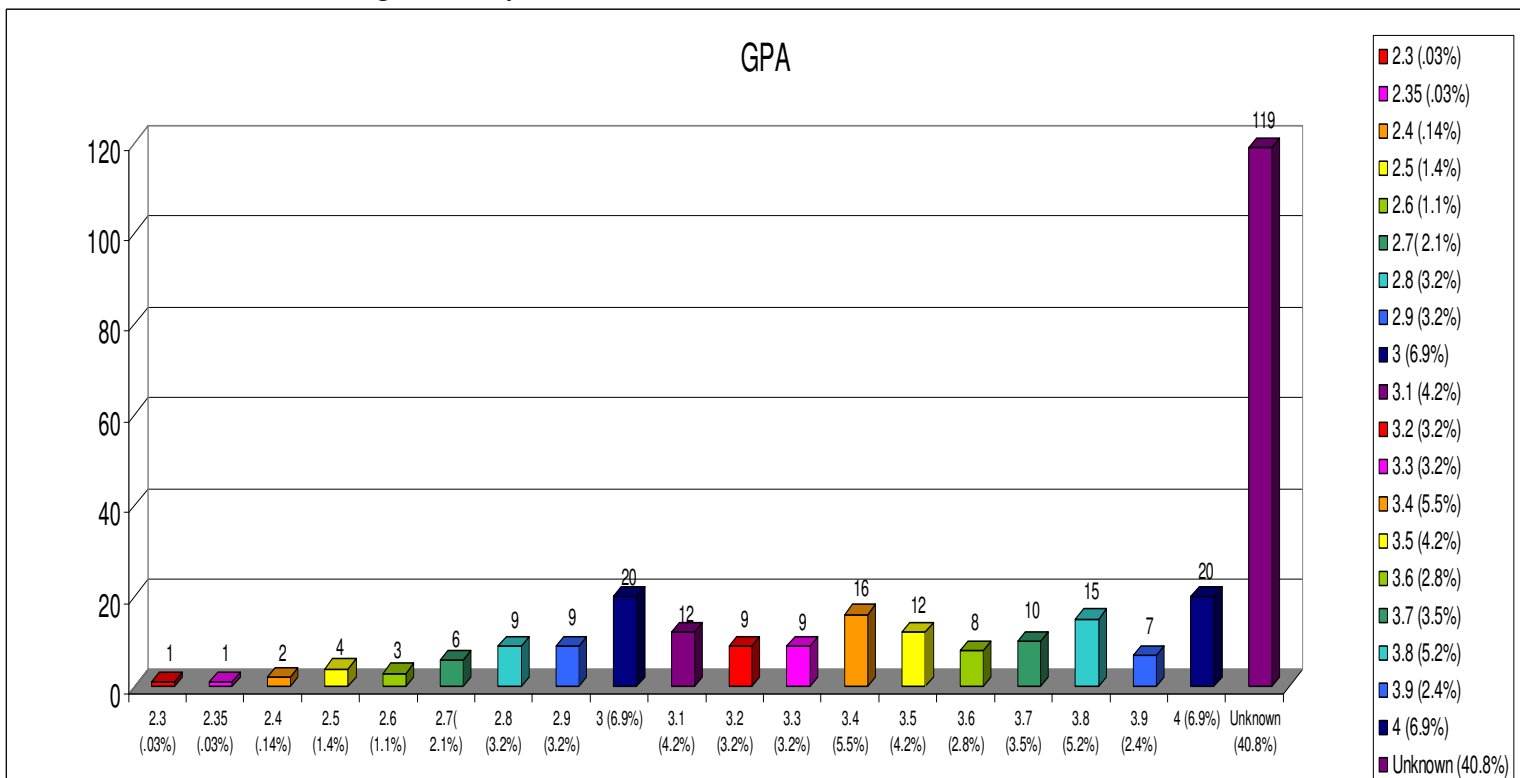
Other Campuses

Overwhelmingly, 230 or 79% attended the Savannah campus while 31 responses reflected use of each the Brunswick and Liberty campuses.



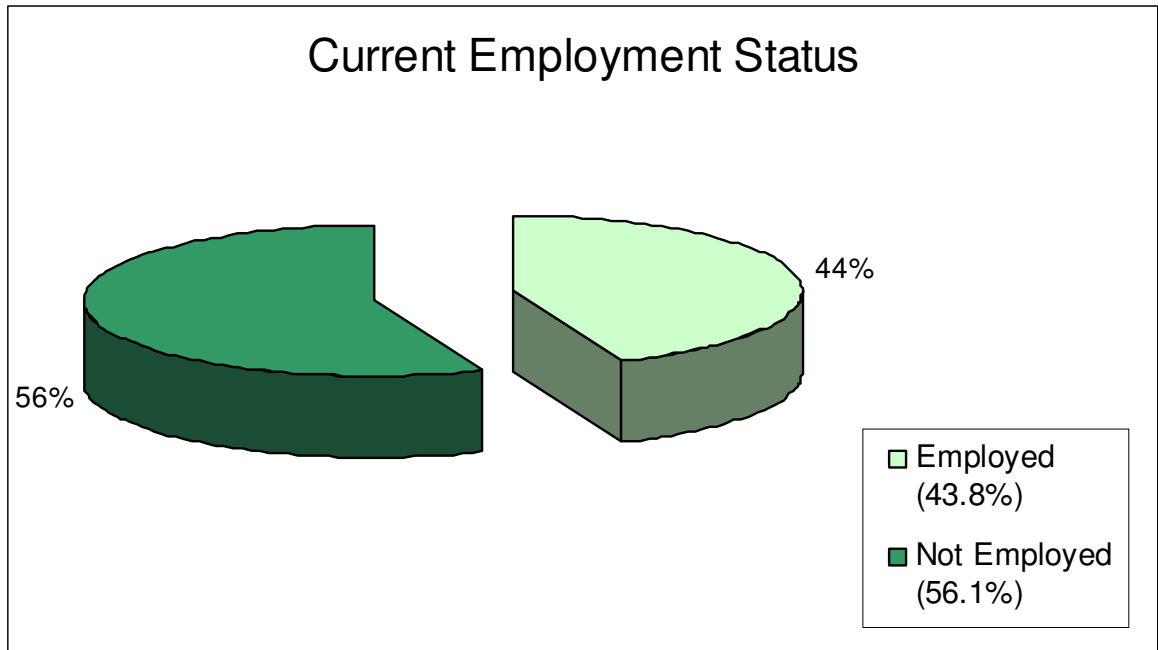
GPA

Of the 173 students who responded to this question, 137 or 79% noted that they graduated with a 3.0 GPA or higher. Only 36 or 21% had between a 2.3 and 2.9 GPA.

128 or 44% of students stated that they were employed and 164 or 56% stated that they were unemployed.



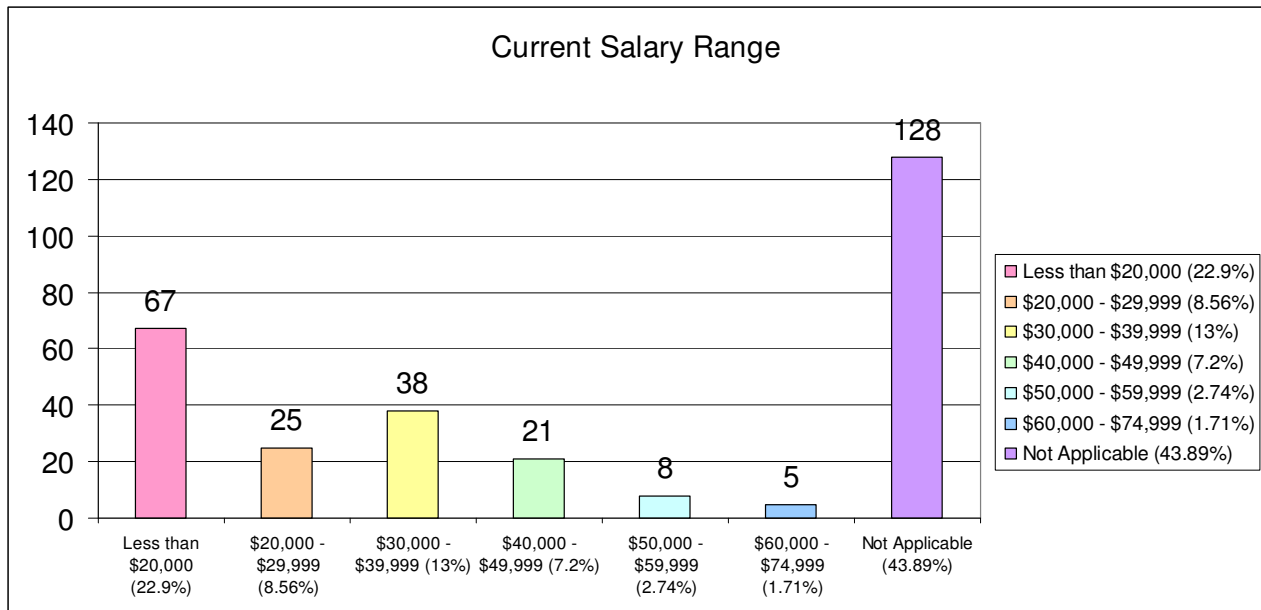

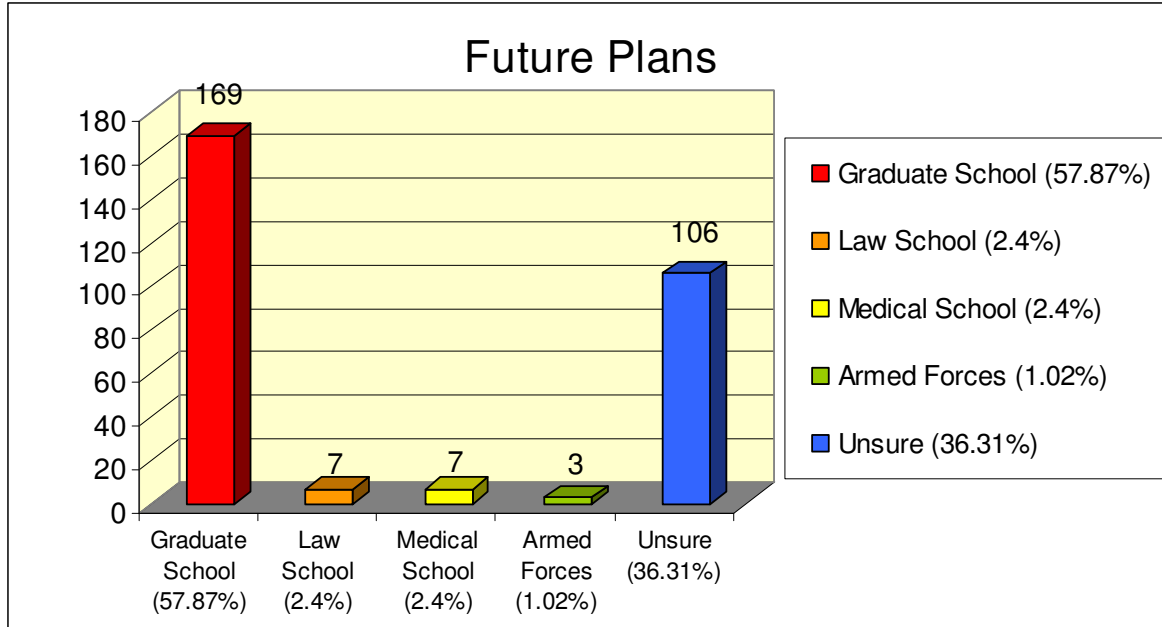
Current Salary Range

Although, there were only 128 student grads who stated they were employed at the time of graduation, 67 responded to making less than \$20,000 and 97 reported making between \$20,000 and \$74,999. The majority of which (72) reported salaries above \$30,000.



Future Plans

An overwhelming number of graduates have plans to pursue Graduate School after graduation at the rate of 169 or 58%. This number coupled with those who will attend law school (7), medical school (7), and armed Forces (3). Account for an overall success rate of 64%. A large number, 106 or 36% were uncertain about future career plans at the time of the survey.



Prospective Future Salary

Out of 292 respondents, 228 or 78% answered this question compared to only 164 or 56% who answered the previous question about current salary. Most graduates 138 or 47% reported prospective salaries between \$40,000 and greater than \$100,000.
